### Remembrance Weekend 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> November.

As part of the British commemoration of the First World War centenary, a film adaptation of the play Journey's End by R. C. Sherriff was filmed and released.

Journey's End is set in northern France in March 1918 as C Company, led by Captain Stanhope arrives to take its turn in the front line. Told that a German offensive is imminent, Stanhope drowns his fears in whisky while the other officers and their cook attempt to distract themselves in their dugout with talk of food and life before the war. They are joined in the trenches by Raleigh, a new young officer fresh out of training who is excited about his first real posting and the chance to serve under his schoolboy hero Stanhope. Raleigh's naïve enthusiasm contrasts with the other men's mounting fear as the tension rises and the attack draws ever closer.

St Peter and St Paul will be showing this film on **Saturday 10th November at 7.30 pm** in the Church and you are warmly invited. Please note this film is rated as 12. There will be no charge to come along but donations can be made (50% will go to the Combat Stress organization). For more information please contact Rev Hughes.
