More may be added to this list in the coming weeks!

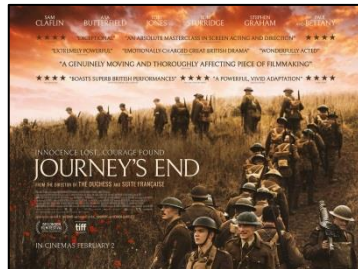
Remembrance Weekend 10th-11th November.
